

SAC Minutes, 14 March 2012  
1500 – Meeting called to order

1. Principal's Report – Enrollment is at 194 as of March 19, 2012.

AdvancEd visit is the end of April- The parent interview day as part of this visit will be Wednesday May 2, 2012 at 9:30 am.
